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Our vision

Ashoka envisions a Europe whose institutions and individuals are agile, adaptive, and creative enough to keep pace with fast, complex change, and to contribute to a thriving and interconnected society and planet.

By 2030, we envision **50 million new people across Europe** having the skills, knowledge, and pathways to actively contribute to a thriving society and planet.

5 core principles

are at the heart of this vision:

- 1 contribute to the change they desire for the common good.
- Success is redefined as contributing to a thriving, interconnected society and planet.
- There is an appropriate "pathway" for everyone to participate.
- 4 Leaders and institutions understand it is their urgent responsibility to create the space for others to contribute.
- Decision-making is inclusive of underrepresented communities and underserved groups.

Community

We achieve this vision by activating an interconnected and purpose-driven community of changemakers with the potential to influence 50 million people and advance an Everyone a Changemaker world.

Our mission is to:

- Strengthen a sense of belonging by connecting community members in enriching, peer-to-peer engagement opportunities where they can share leadership experiences and build trustworthy relationships.
- Engage community members in pathways for changemaking to advance systemic impact and an Everyone a Changemaker world.
- Foster multi-stakeholder collaborations on specific purpose areas and topics catalyzing social change for the good of all.
- Support local offices to define and implement their community engagement strategy and adopt Ashoka's frameworks, tools, and methodologies.

Our main achievements

The Ashoka Europe Fellowship
Program, set up in 2018, has in 2023
enlarged its scope and efforts
gradually becoming the **Ashoka Europe One Community Program**,
with the goal of encouraging active
changemaking in Europe and beyond.

01.Connect

Community Engagement

To achieve our goal of activating an interconnected and **purpose-driven community** with the potential to influence 50 million people by 2030, we have identified three main levers of work:

- Increasing the sense of trust and transparency in our diverse community.
- Improving access to the already existing Ashoka community offers.
- Fostering the collaboration potential of a diverse Ashoka community.

This allowed us to:

- Define a set of values and principles to guide the Ashoka Community's work in Europe.
- Define Diversity, Equity & Inclusion guidelines for community experiences.
- Develop engagement pathways for Ashoka Fellows, Young People, Ashoka Support Network Members, Local Changemakers, and Partners.
- Open an internal communications channel for Ashoka Staff Members to communicate more directly, exchange experiences and opportunities, and ask for support.

- 30 community interviews with members of the Ashoka Community (Ashoka Fellows, Ashoka Support Network members, Young People, partners, Panelists, and Ashoka Staff members) to understand emerging needs.
- 10 in-depth dialogues with colleagues across Europe to map the local context and practices.
- 4 internal workshops with pan-European teams to understand the needs of different community members.
- 1 new onboarding toolbox with resources for new Ashoka Community Managers in Europe.



Communications

The One Community website is a new, up-to-date space that centralizes the Ashoka community offers across Europe and beyond.

The platform offers a wide overview of events, learning journeys, collaboration initiatives, and opensource resources, all in the same place.

Our impact

Ashoka Community work has also been communicated externally via Ashoka's global social media handles, with over 230,000 followers just on LinkedIn.

Ashoka Fellows and network partner organizations have reached out to us regularly to promote their updates and events on the One Community communication channels.

- From August 2023 to July 2024 more than 20,000 people have navigated through the One Community website, and over 2,100 people have interacted with Ashoka's learning offers.
- Ashoka country offices in Europe have included their community updates (events, news, learning journeys, etc.) on the platform, and communicated about it widely across their channels, including digital newsletters, social media outreach, and their local websites.

Community Pulse

Community Gatherings

A safe space to meet as full humans and connect.

Community Gatherings are an online space hosted **every three months**, with topics and formats varying based on the interest of our community.

They are designed based on the needs and inputs that emerged during our interviews with community members.

02.Learn

To drive transformational impact, we must learn how to <u>co-create change</u>.

In short

- Trained Ashoka staff on systems change and raised awareness of systems thinking through an introductory course and our flagship Masterclass.
- Engaged philanthropists in a learning experience on systems change.
- Advanced team collaborations toward systems change through a new iteration of our multi-stakeholder collaborations course.
- Co-created DE&I learning journey with Ashoka Fellows and Young Changemakers.
- Supported Ashoka Fellows and other changemakers in replicating their solutions and diversifying their funding sources.
- Co-created wellbeing spaces with Ashoka Fellows.
- Piloted a new online learning platform to support and improve the quality of our offers and developed new online courses to reach a bigger audience.
- Featured all Ashoka learning experiences in one place, such as the Ashoka Visionary Program and the Future of Business course.

Systems Change

3400+ individuals globally are more aware and equipped with the tools, mindset, and connections to generate systems change and drive meaningful social change, both within their systems of influence and in broader societal contexts.

They gained insights on:

- Systems thinking & holistic perspective.
- Reflective practice on leadership for systems change.
- Framework and mindset for collaborative innovation.
- Funding and measuring systems change.

"The experience enabled us to rethink our theory of change, gather the team around this new vision, and broaden our activities to advance toward systemic change for women and LGBTIQ+ people. It also connected me with amazing changemakers, the Ashoka Support Network, and the Ashoka team."

- Facilitated a train-the-trainer program for Ashoka staff piloted between October 2022 and February 2023 where 9 Ashokans were trained as systems change champions and guided 44 community members to develop their systems change strategy.
- Facilitated two editions of a new Introduction to Systems Change course in November 2023 and April 2024 with 243 participants globally.
- Piloted a Journey for
 Philanthropists on systems
 change in April 2024 with 50
 funders and partners.
- Introduced systems thinking to around 100 employees and changemakers in several collaborations with global partners.

Leading multistakeholder collaborations

215+ individuals and teams globally gained new knowledge and skills to manage complexity, foster innovation, and lead collective action and multistakeholder collaborations in a more effective, equitable, and systemic way toward meaningful social change.

17 collaborative initiatives from around the world supported and equipped with the tools, mindsets, and methodologies to deepen their collaboration processes.

- Piloted a new 2-phase format of the facilitated course between January and April 2023, and selected 138 participants out of 221 applicants engaging people beyond our core community around collaboration.
- Revamped and launched in May 2024 a self-paced online course with our partner CoCreative.
- Facilitated a three-month
 experiential learning journey
 (piloted on our new online
 learning platform) designed for
 existing collaborative initiatives
 within and beyond Ashoka's
 community. This journey enabled
 spaces for learning and
 practicing for 17 teams with a
 total of 79 participants.
- Delivered in-person workshops for partners.

Wellbeing

250+ changemakers

- Developed greater resilience to lead and make change effectively amid pressure, stress, and complex circumstances.
- Were equipped with tools and techniques to support their wellbeing.
- Understood the importance of wellbeing when navigating complexity successfully, practicing effective leadership, and creating healthy systemic change.
- Connected with other changemakers and felt part of a community of like-minded individuals from around the world.

"Through this journey, I was able to have to time have indepth reflections on different aspects of wellbeing and acquire practical skills and tools to achieve wellbeing and help promote wellbeing amongst my team and the people we work with. It was a wonderful experience that I would highly recommend to all changemakers".

- Launched and animated a community of practice on Wellbeing in collaboration with Global Learning & Development with 38 wellbeing champions from all over the world between December 2022 and May 2024.
- A community of practice on Mindfulness for Changemakers ideated from the community and launched successfully in September 2023 with 170+ members globally.
- Strengthened a pro-bono international network of coaches and mentors for the community, and matched 30 community members in two years.
- Supported a local Ashoka team in the development of a wellbeing program for Fellows.
- Co-created a session on Burnout in the media with one Fellow in June 2024.

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

210+ changemakers individually and collectively reflected on unconscious bias, power dynamics, leadership, and strategies for inclusion with a special focus on intersectionality and are now equipped to make changemaking open and inclusive for everybody.

According to the feedback survey conducted after the first edition:

- **88,9%** of participants have made changes to their strategies after the module.
- 88,8% of participants see their roles as leaders differently.
- 89,5% of participants said the experience has helped them advance their work in creating an Everyone a Changemaker world.

"During the journey, I met Ashoka Fellows whose expertise has resonated with me after the module and I am quoting them in my work. Those lessons are vivid because they allowed me to work through this experience".

- Piloted two editions of a learning journey on DE&I cocreated with Fellows and other community members with interest received from 400 community members.
- Gathered the insights and reflections on DE&I from 16 guest speakers (Ashoka Fellows, Ashoka staff, and Young Changemakers) and captured the knowledge in video recordings that will be used to develop a self-paced course.
- Piloted the facilitation of the experience of the second edition on a new online learning platform and created the structure for a self-paced course.

Replication & Transfer

139 Ashoka Fellows and changemakers supported in the process of **building a replication** and transfer model.

A strategy to replicate their initiatives in other countries and engage thousands of people in new roles that empower them to become changemakers.



- Facilitated two editions of the course for 139 community members, with on-demand personalized feedback sessions, and restructured the experience in the second year.
- Developed and released a selfpaced online course run in parallel with the facilitation of the second edition.

Changemaker Finance

69 community members were **introduced to the concept** of changemaker finance and learned how to navigate blended financing approaches to diversify their social investment opportunities and unlock untapped resources.

- Created and launched a series of self-paced videos on Changemaker Finance based on the content of the workshops and uploaded them on our new online learning platform.







What we observe

+45% registrations compared to **FY22.** Increased interest from the community with a very high and growing number of registrations to our learning offers every year.

A substantial number of people between **40% and 50%**, **consistently participate** in our learning offers, and those are mainly members of our core community with the Ashoka Fellows' teams having the most constant engagement.

Some of the offers of a more introductory nature attract a larger and more diverse group of people whose commitment is, however, lower.




03.Collaborate

Collaborate as an ecosystem of changemakers, together.

In short

- We piloted an accelerator to transform the field of migration through collaborative frameworks with Ashoka Hello Europe.
- Re-imagined new narratives around the future of the health workforce.
- Accompanied a group of social entrepreneurs in Europe to change the gender narrative and joined an international community moved by the same mission.
- Continued to support the Elders
 Council for Social
 Entrepreneurs in their new
 organizational life phase.
- Gathered insights and codeveloped a report on the potential of collaborations between INGOs and social entrepreneurs to transform global development.
- Facilitated the creation of a coalition of Fellows working on mental health in Europe.

Migration

In collaboration with the Ashoka Hello Europe Initiative, we facilitated an innovative 10-month Ecosystem Accelerator in the field of migrant entrepreneurship & employment with a core group of 17 ecosystem leaders.



- The Accelerator paved the way
 for the formulation of the report
 Transforming the Field of
 Migration through
 Collaborative Frameworks
 which analyses the major
 barriers encountered by
 migrants in this field.
- The report also showcases key recommendations designed by the accelerator participants to build an interconnected, resilient, and functional migrant workforce and entrepreneurial ecosystem where migrants can thrive.





- The report was enriched by a
 virtual validation and feedback
 session with representatives of
 all stakeholder groups relevant
 to the field and by the insights
 gathered by the group during an
 ecosystem event in Berlin with
 local migrant changemakers and
 experts on the topic.
- An <u>online event</u> was organized in November 2023 to officially present the report.



Health Agency

As part of a **three-year partnership** with the Johnson & Johnson Foundation, we have deepened our work in the field of health, rethinking what the **future of health** may look like.

Through this work:

- We surfaced social entrepreneurs working in community health
- We equipped five of them with skills to deepen their work at a systemic level
- We are now enabling four multistakeholder collaborations to imagine new narratives around the future of the health workforce.

- In 2023, we facilitated a tailored learning journey for the "Reimagining Community Health" challenge winners and held a two-day meeting in Utrecht, which led to a pan-European collaboration among the social entrepreneurs.
- In 2024, we convened three social entrepreneurs in the UK, the Netherlands, and France who each brought together local health stakeholders to reimagine the future of the healthcare workforce together.
- The social entrepreneurs brought together 30+ stakeholders - policymakers, doctors, patients, health insurers, and other actors - to develop new local narratives, and are disseminating them together across health spaces.

Gender Equality

To understand how to best respond to the setback caused by the pandemic, in 2021 we **mapped the European systems changers' ecosystem**, interviewed 30 of them, and from March 2022, brought 10 social entrepreneurs together for a **collective journey**.

- The analysis, case studies, and insights from the group conversations were gathered in the report How Social
 Entrepreneurs Tackle Gender Inequality Following COVID-19
 published in November 2022.
- The collaboration initiative also resulted in the co-creation of a podcast series and Manifesto for a new gender narrative that was presented to the community at the Ashoka Changemaker Summit 2022 in Brussels.



What we did

This work has now been integrated into a bigger **global effort** of an **international community** of 19 Ashoka Fellows and staff reshaping together the narrative on gender equity who met in Mexico City in September 2023 and started an online journey to advance their work.

Eldership & Transition

The Elders Council for Social
Entrepreneurs is an initiative cocreated with Ashoka Fellows in 2018
that is building a global network of
support and learning for senior
social entrepreneurs.

These past two years, we continued to play the role of **strategic consultants** and accompanied them during their new organizational life phase as they became a registered charity in England and Wales.



We also supported the promotion of their **webinars** and the dissemination of major announcements with the publication of **27 posts** on Ashoka's social media accounts and the Community Pulse Newsletter.

Reframing Global Development

We co-developed a report with other Ashoka teams and partners that identified **14 actions** that INGOs, social entrepreneurs, funders, and intermediaries can take to **unlock the potential of these collaborations** to scale impact and drive systemic change.

The insights are based on:

- interviews with 35 social entrepreneurs and innovation leaders, mostly from INGOs.
- a survey shared with 29 social entrepreneurs.
- round tables, workshops, and informal discussions with many social innovators.
- 50 peer-reviews by innovators from the field.
